**Dinosaur Valley State Park, Glen Rose, TX**

**RACE DESCRIPTION**

The course features primarily tight and twisty single track with some challenging climbs. The course is very rocky and loose. Riders will be doing multiple laps (approx 5 miles per lap), see below for lap counts

**PRE-RIDE:** Course is open for pre-ride Saturday afternoon (1:00 PM–4:00 PM) and Sunday morning (8:00 AM–9:00 AM). We recommend all riders pre-ride the course. *Please pass course workers with great care.*

**DIRECTIONS:** Entry to Dinosaur Valley State Park will be through the back gate AND NOT THE MAIN GATE. PLEASE DO NOT GO TO THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF DINOSAUR VALLEY STATE PARK.

- Entrance to Dinosaur Valley State Park will be through the back gate at the following coordinates:

- You will need to enter this back entrance to Dinosaur Valley State Park from the North. From Glen Rose at the intersection of highway 67 onto highway 56 / Hereford St. Follow Highway 56 until the intersection of Highway 1007. Turn onto Highway 1007 and follow it until you see the League Wind Wings on the side of the road. See the map below.

**FEES:**

- Dinosaur Valley State Park will NOT charge any fees for camping or day use if you enter through the back gate, per the instructions above.

**ACCOMODATIONS:**

- Local Hotels.
- Camping at Dinosaur Valley State Park:
  - All camping will be in the pasture where the race will originate from. No signups are required.
  - Shower facilities are a short ¼ mile walk from the pasture.
  - No power or water hook ups are available. Feel free to bring generators. We recommend commercial quiet generators, rather than industrial generators.
- **IMPORTANT DETAILS HERE:** Entry to Dinosaur Valley State Park will be through the back gate AND NOT THE MAIN GATE. PLEASE DO NOT GO TO THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF DINOSAUR VALLEY STATE PARK.

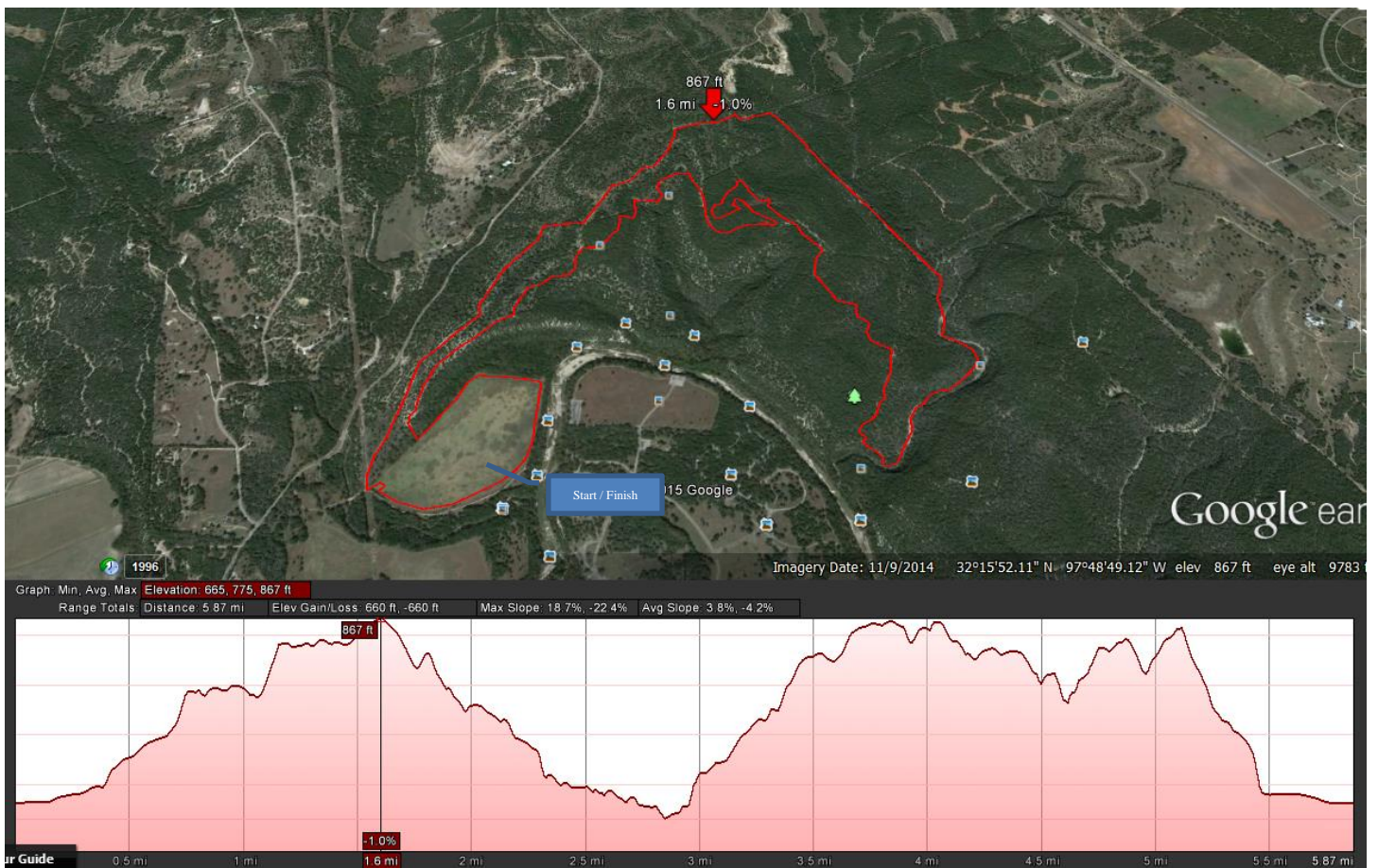

### Course Description:

This course is all kinds of fun! It is 5.9 miles in length, there is 660 feet of elevation gain. You will spend the first 1.6 miles climbing to the highest point. This is shown on the map above by the red arrow. You will follow a clock wise rotation on the course. The start / finish will be in the location of the blue line and box above.

The course is very rocky and there is a lot of cactus. Be sure that you know how to change a flat tire and are carrying the tools to do so.

This course will force you to get in a proper ready / attack position in many places. In a few places the steepness of the course will require that you get behind your saddle, while in the attack position. Here is a reminder:
